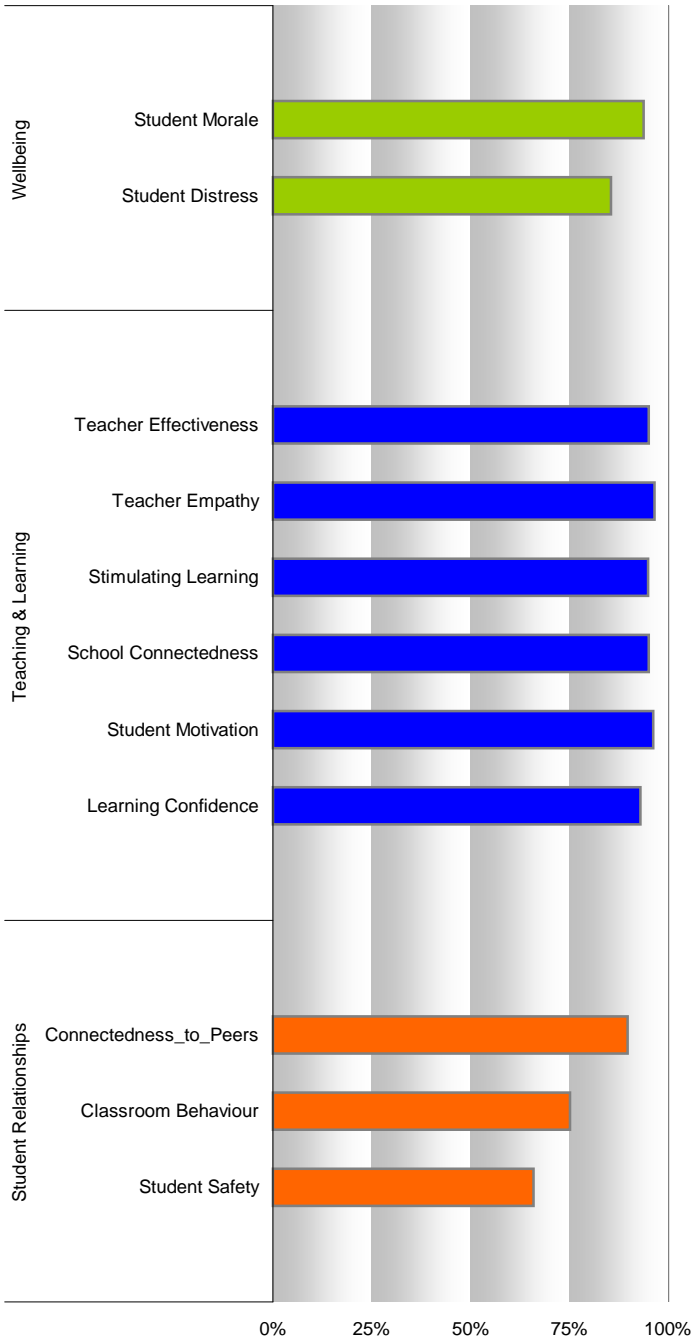


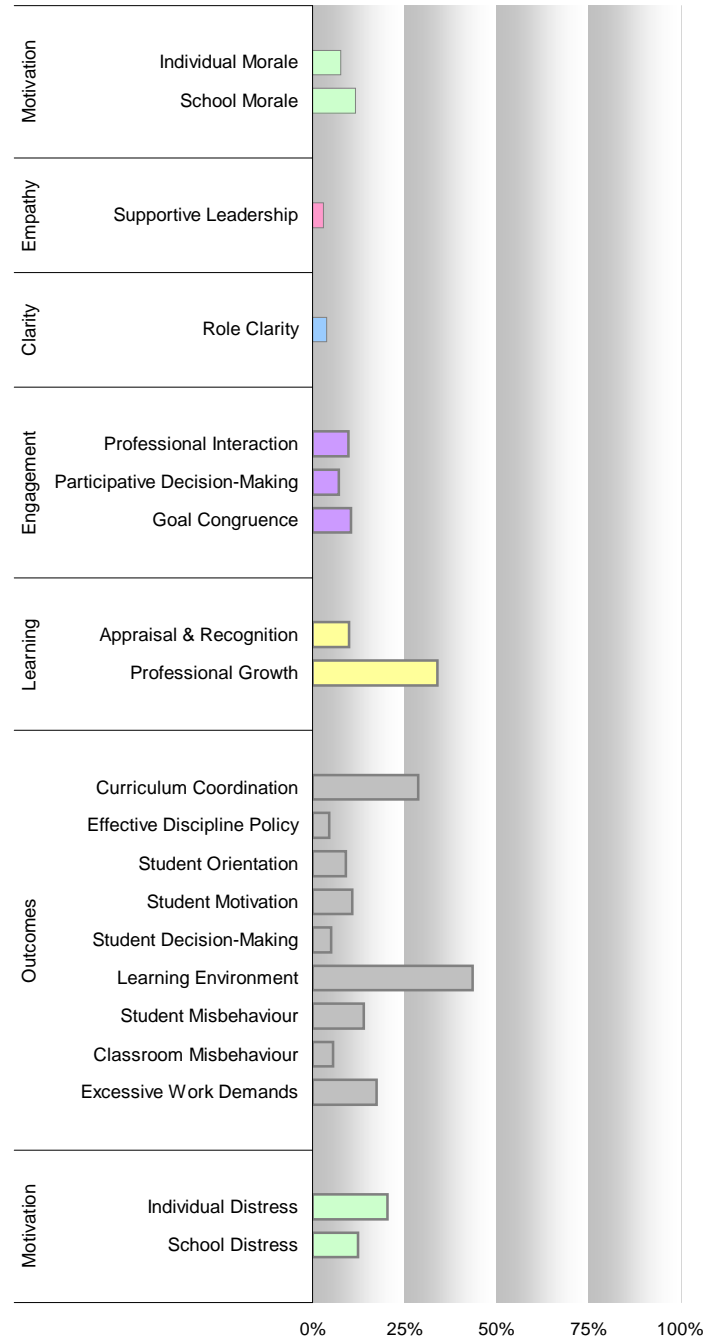

Strengths and Weaknesses against all schools with yr5-6 data



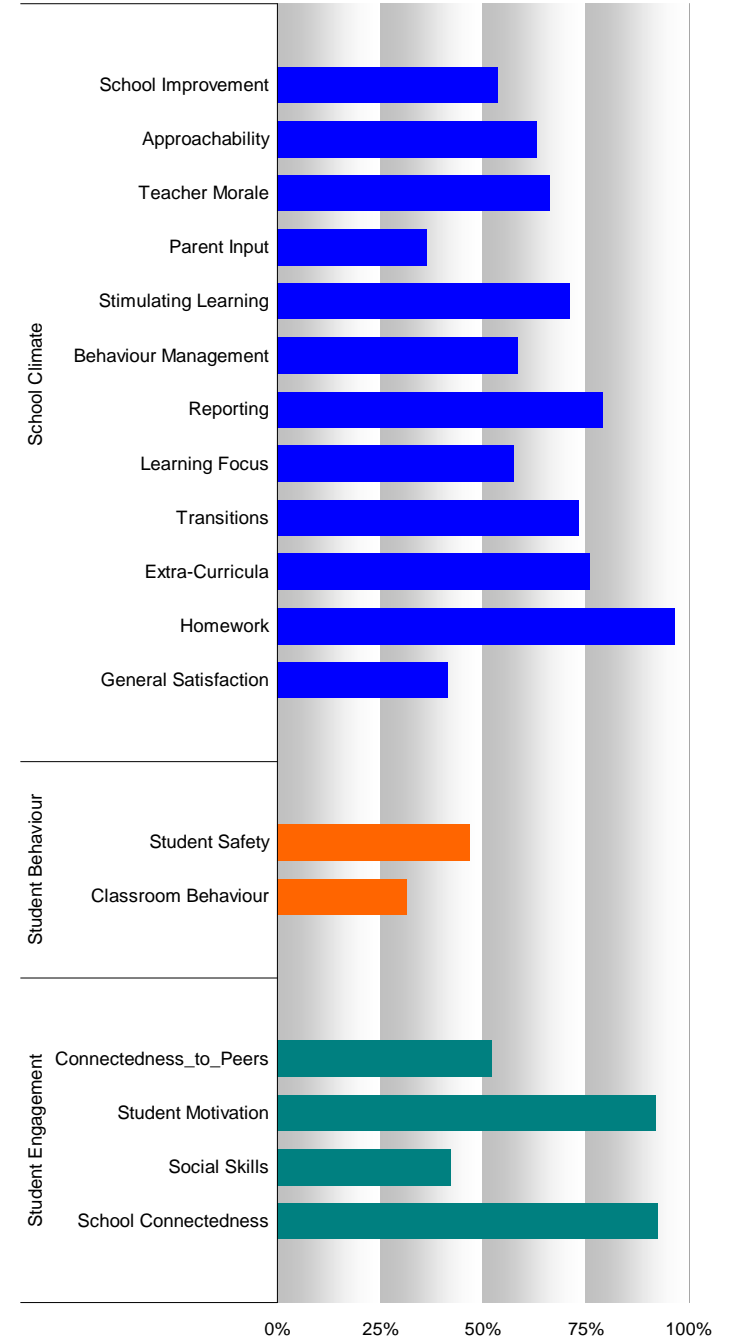

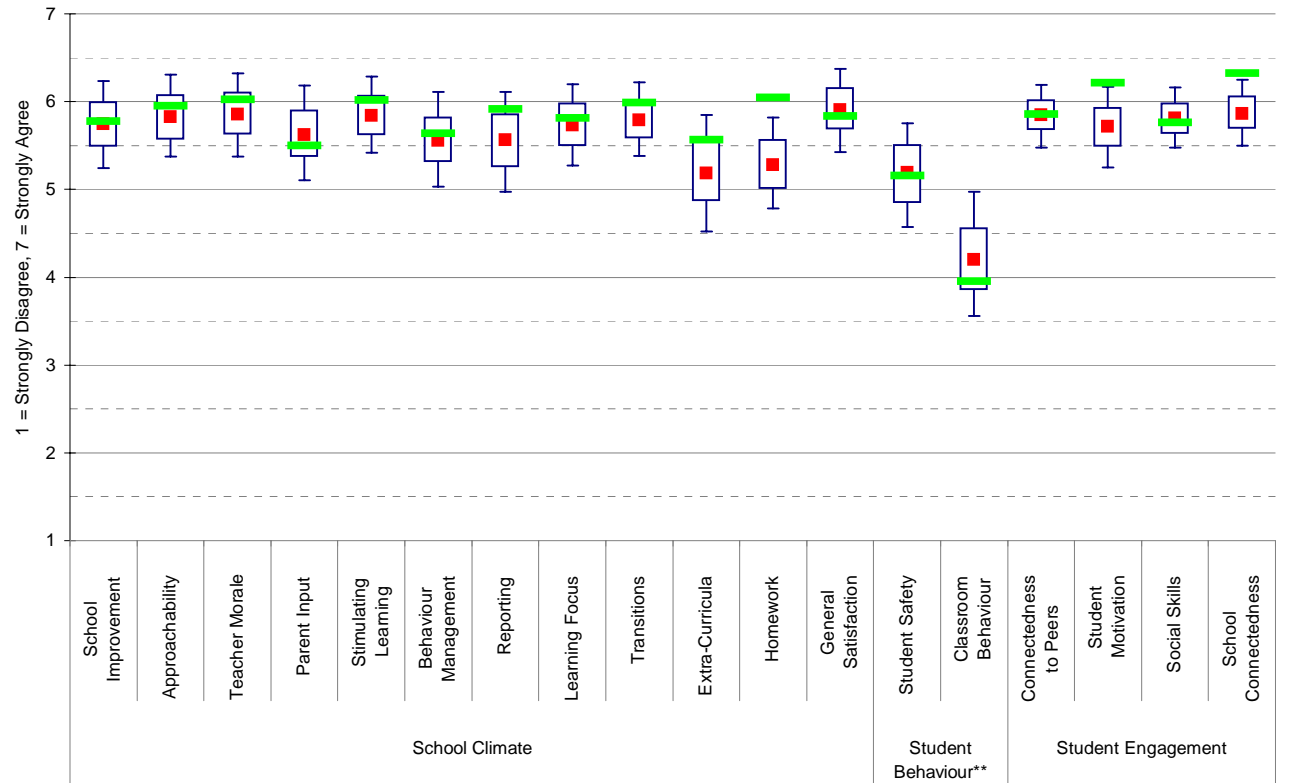

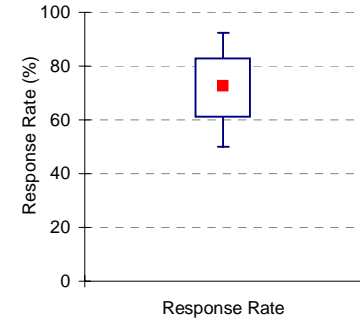
2008 Data against Primary School benchmarks

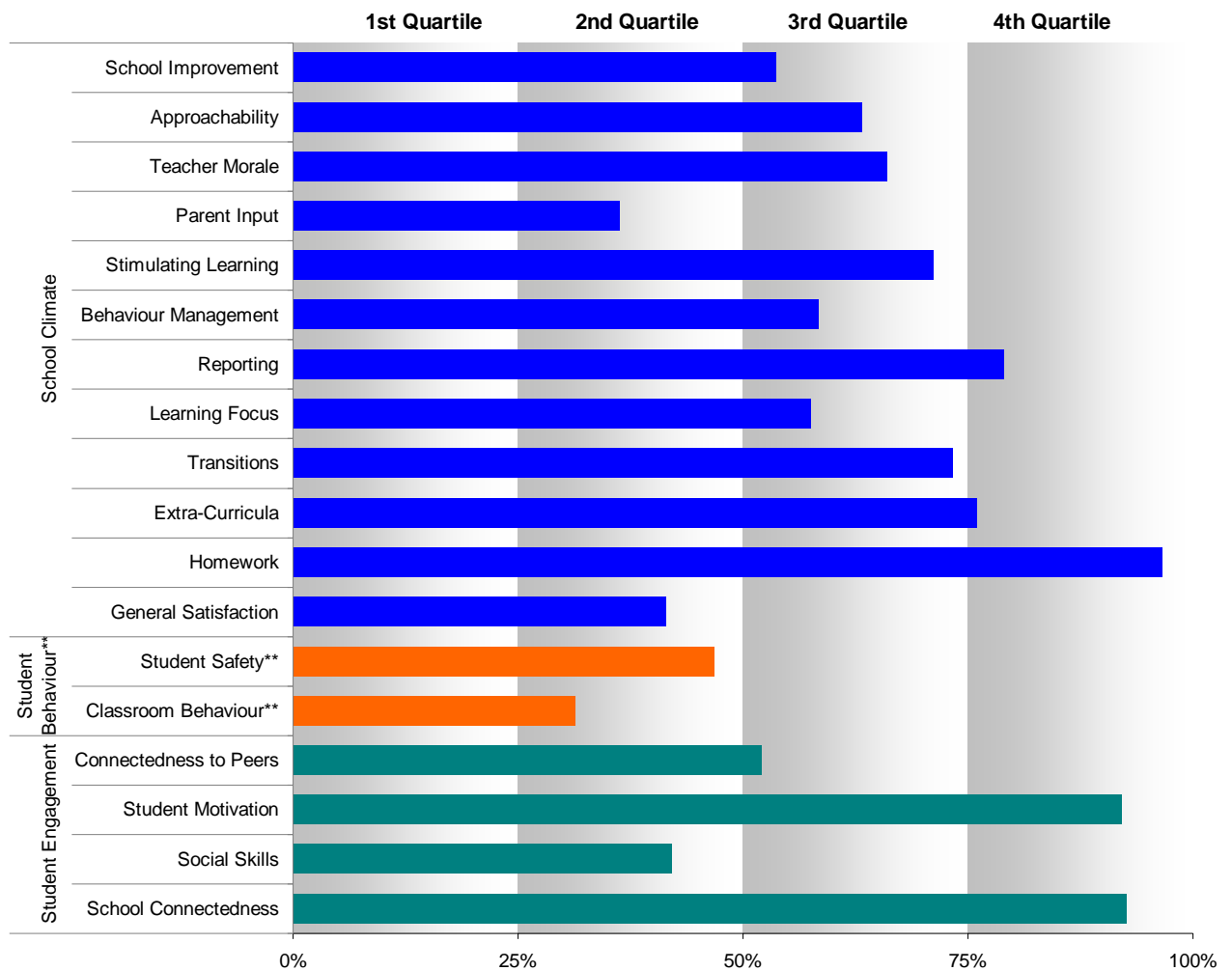

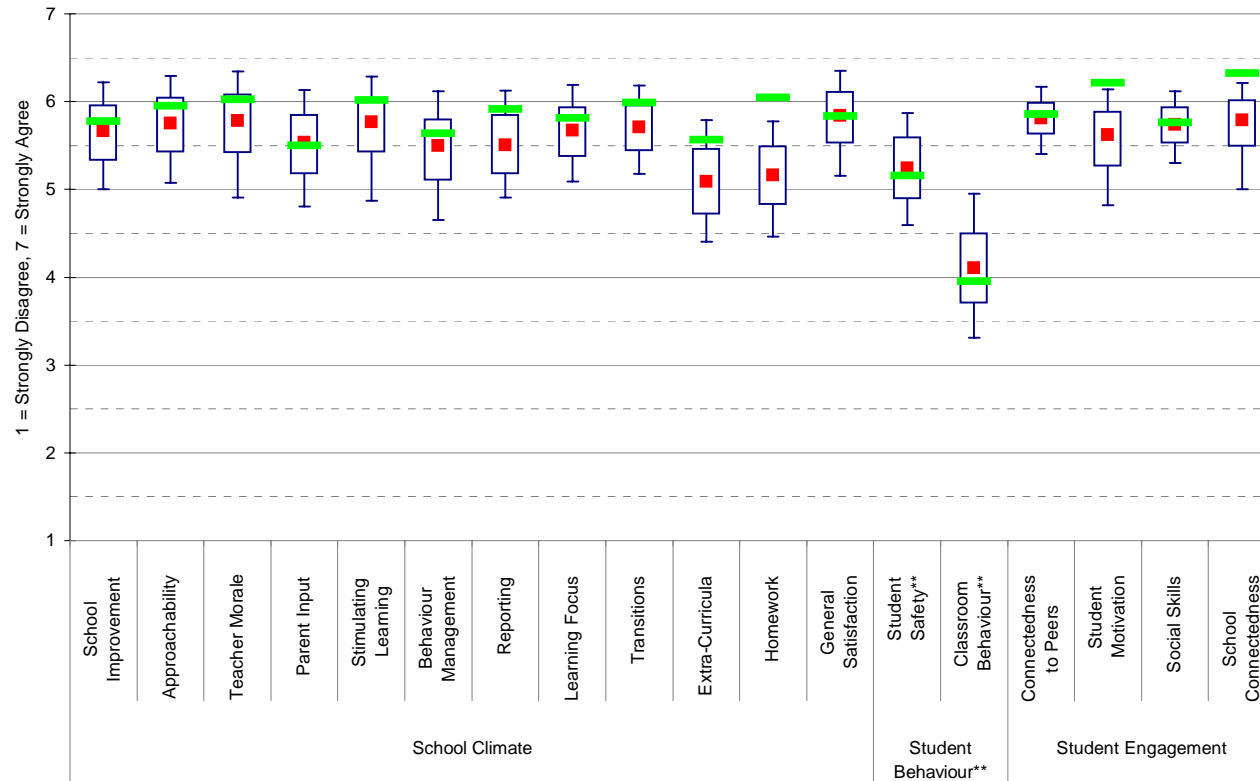

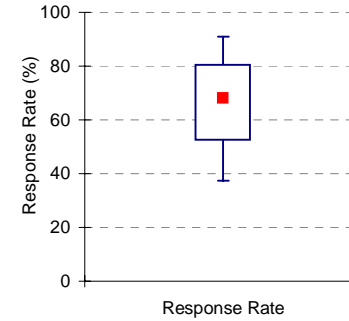
2008 Data against state-wide school benchmarks

School means plotted against distribution of state-wide school means



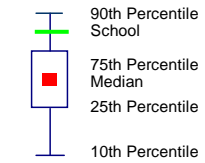

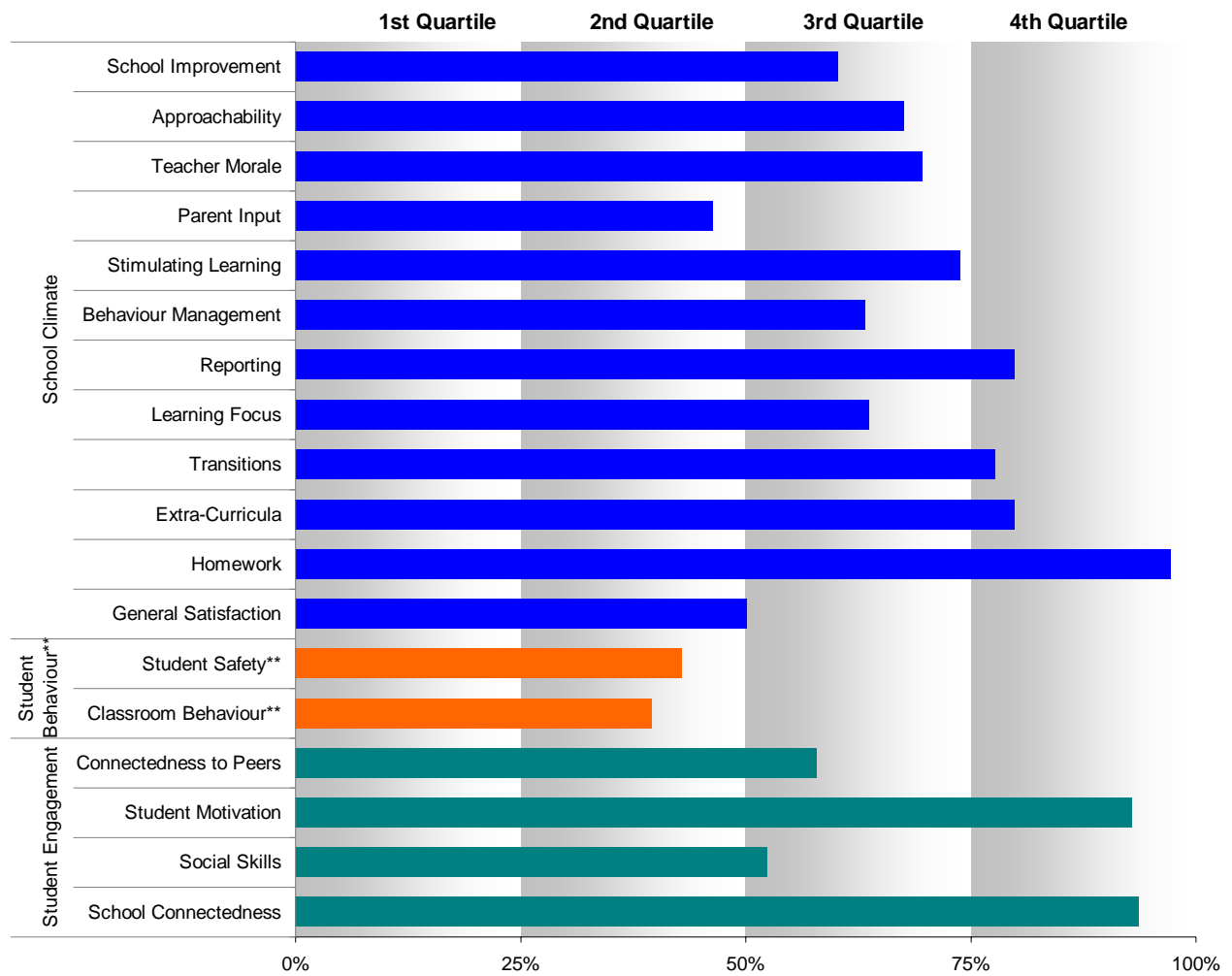

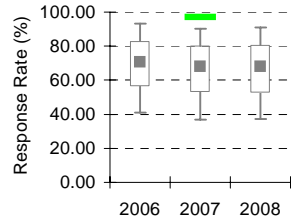

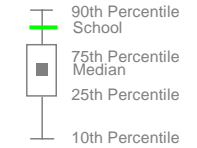

School response rate plotted against state-wide school distribution

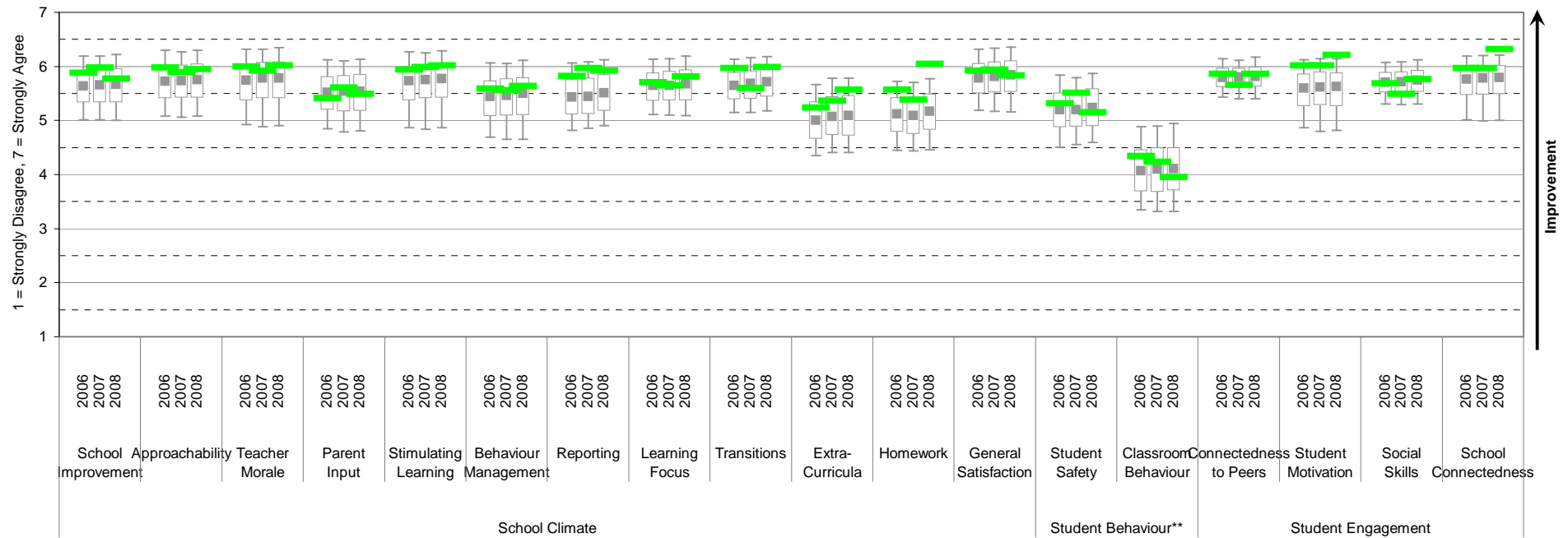

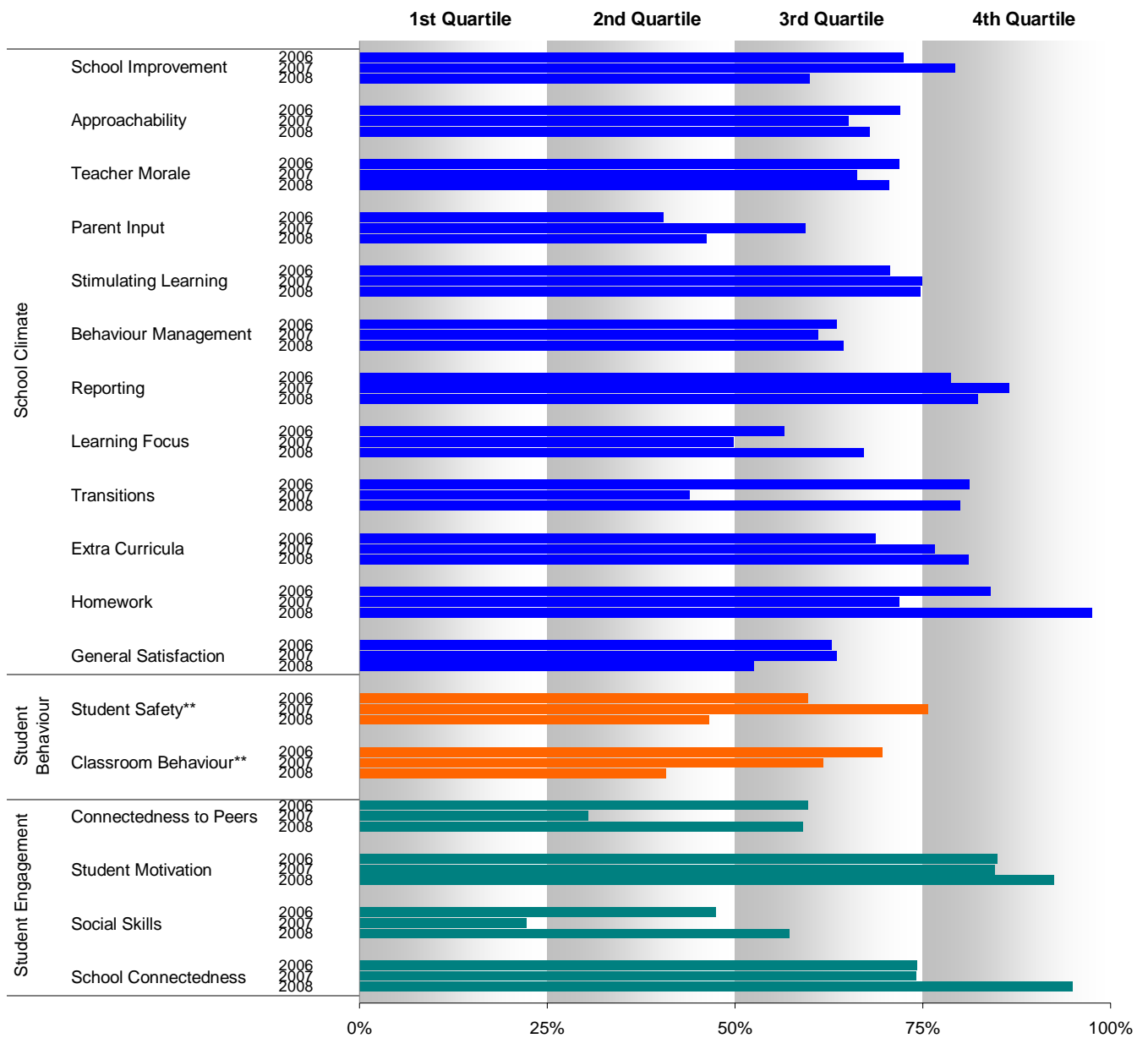
